Before joining SeniorNet in 2001, Professor Rawn had a distinguished career as a University Professor of Psychology, private practice psychologist, author and consultant at many psychiatric hospitals, clinics and state institutions. He published peer reviewed articles in psychology, psychotherapy and psychoanalysis.

Upon retirement Professor Rawn joined SeniorNet, first as a student and then immediately joined the team of SeniorNet volunteers.

From the start Professor Rawn revolutionized the education committee by creating a faculty and a curriculum. He trained teachers and coaches and wrote teaching material suited for seniors training in computer skills. With enthusiasm, knowledge, and most of all with a great sense of humor, he taught seniors 80 plus the computer skills that had eluded their generation.

Soon after, Moss stepped forward and became coordinator of the SeniorNet council. Under his leadership, SeniorNet received many awards and proclamations and was recognized by the SeniorNet National organization as an innovator in the art of teaching the senior population as well as providing guidance to all other committees.
